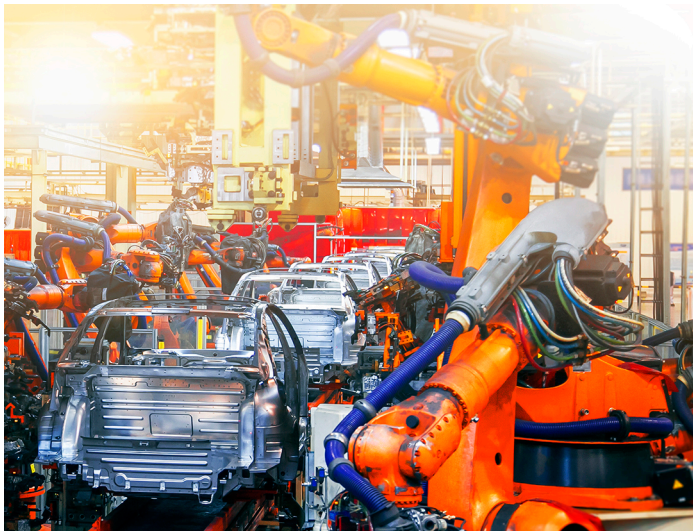

Martinrea International Inc., a Canadian automotive supplier and parent company of **Vari-Form**, is expanding into Amory with a \$35.5 million investment that will create 75 new local jobs.

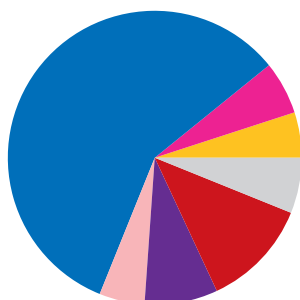


70 Canadian-owned companies employ 4,000 workers in Mississippi

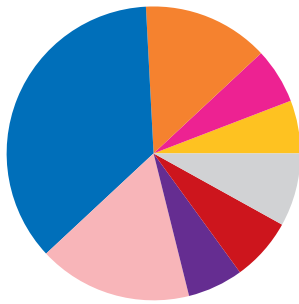


Mancuso creates jobs in Mississippi

Mancuso Chemicals Limited, a Canadian specialty chemical manufacturer headquartered in Niagara Falls, Ontario, is expanding into the U.S. with a new logistics distribution center in Pachuta. The \$5.52 million investment will create 17 jobs and strengthen the company's ability to serve customers across the Southern United States. Mancuso's Mississippi facility highlights the state's growing role in global supply chains, as products manufactured and distributed here will support industries ranging from automotive fluids and metalworking to paints and phenolic resins.

This expansion underscores the deep trade and investment ties between Canada and Mississippi. Mancuso's decision to establish operations in the state reflects the importance of cross-border collaboration. By anchoring its U.S. presence in Mississippi, Mancuso not only enhances export opportunities but also reinforces the critical role of Canadian innovation in driving growth across North America.
